Attendance Reminders from the Student Handbook

- 1. Please remember to fill out attendance forms on your child's sapphire portal.

 These forms must be filled out within three days of your student's absence returning or the absence will be marked unlawful. A phone call is not accepted by the district in place of a form filled out in sapphire.

- 2. The attendance secretary sends a letter home after each unlawful absence.
- 3. Per state attendance code, after three unlawful absences, an attendance plan will need to be put in place.
