# ABOUT THE BAND

The West York Area High School Band begins each year with a week of intensive music and marching rehearsals during their annual "Band Camp" which was held this August at Camp Ramblewood in Darlington, Maryland.

During the fall, the band performs at home and away football games and for numerous school and civic occasions. Often featured are the majorettes, coached by Wanda Reider, and the "A-Line" coached by Mrs. Gwen Shaffer.

The Symphonic Band is offered as an elective curricular subject meeting three periods per week for full academic credit, and performs 3 major concerts each year. In addition, many students participate in solo work and small ensembles meeting after school and evenings.

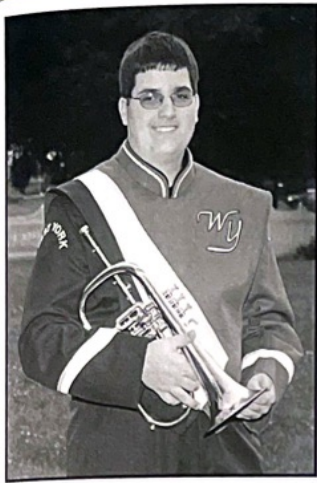
In addition to concerts presented in the York area, the band also travels occasionally and has performed throughout Pennsylvania and many other states and Canada. Ensembles have performed at clinics and/or concerts at many Pennsylvania colleges, the PMEA State Convention, on television, the State Capitol in Harrisburg, and for numerous civic and church organizations in the area. Highlighting the band's past activities are performances in Mexico City (1972), Disney World (1974 & 1979), Nashville, Tennessee (1983), Toronto, Canada (1982, 1990 & 1996), Boston, Massachusetts (1984 & 1988), and Bermuda (1992). The band has also performed at the Mid-East Band Clinic in Pittsburgh, the Eastern Band Conductors Conference and has twice been selected to perform for the Pennsylvania Music Educators Association State Conference (1982 & 1989). In 1998, the band traveled to Toronto, Canada and participated in the Toronto "Festivals of Music" where they were awarded the "William D. Revelli Outstanding Concert Band" award for the most outstanding band in the festival. In 2000, the band traveled to the Cedar Point Music Festival in Ohio where they earned a superior rating. In 2003, the band toured Orlando, Sarasota, Naples, and Miami, Florida. The band took a concert tour to Virginia Beach in the spring of 2007.

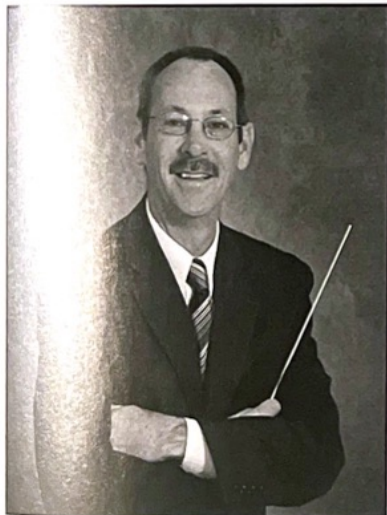
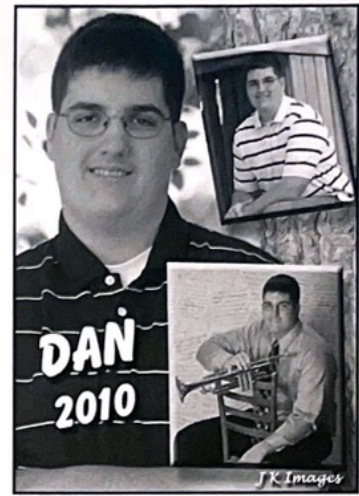

## OUR DIRECTOR - MR. THOMAS EYSTER

Thomas Eyster is in his 33rd year as director of instrumental music at West York Area High School. He is also the Instructional Leader for the Music Department for the West York Area School District. During his tenure at West York, the symphonic band has received numerous superior ratings at state and national adjudications and have been a featured performing ensemble for the PMEA State Conferences several times. Prior to "coming home" to West York, Mr. Eyster taught for one year in the Upper Darby School District in Delaware County, Pennsylvania.

A graduate of West York, Mr. Eyster received his B.M. Degree in Music Education from Susquehanna University and has done additional study in music education and conducting at Peabody Conservatory of Music and Duquesne University and Loyola College of Maryland.

In addition to his duties at West York, Mr. Eyster has served as an adjudicator, clinician, and guest conductor in Pennsylvania and Maryland. He also serves as director of the concert band for Youth Music Abroad and served as associate music director for the Pennsylvania Ambassadors of Music concert band for their bi-annual European concert tours. Mr. Eyster was also an assistant director of the York All-County Band formed for the City of York's 250th Anniversary. In 1989, he was awarded a "Citation of Excellence" by the National Band Association for outstanding contributions to concert bands and band music. Mr. Eyster is also listed in several editions of "Who's Who Among America Teachers".

Mr. Eyster is a member of the P.S.E.A. and N.E.A., the National Band Association, International Association of Jazz Educators, Pennsylvania Music Educators Association, and the Music Educators National Conference. Other societies to his credit include life memberships to Phi Mu Alpha (professional music fraternity), Phi Beta Mu (national bandmaster fraternity) and Phi Sigma Kappa (national social fraternity).

## THE YEAR IN REVIEW 2009-2010

The West York Band has had another outstanding year. Between the marching, concert, and jazz ensembles, as well as the annual musical, the band brought another year of musical sensations to the West York Area School District.

The band season took off at an encouraging pace with the marching band's endeavors. The band's devoted members were memorizing and rehearsing their music as early as the "Minicamp" in July, but the band's efforts truly came together during the annual band camp in August. It was at this camp - Camp Ramblewood, located in scenic Darlington, Maryland - that the band learned the season's full show. Aptly named Piano Man, the season's show featured music by the legendary pianist and songwriter Billy Joel.

The marching band returned to York, PA just in time for the start of another busy school year. It may have been tough to balance rehearsals with schoolwork, sports, and other extracurricular events, but the band always put forth an inspiring display of effort at both the weekly rehearsals and the Friday football performances. Dressed in brand new marching band uniforms, the band was a hit at home games and away matches alike. The football team put in a matching effort, and together West York earned a streak of victories. The band travelled with the football team through the season, on to the District-level matches, and all the way to just two games shy of the State Championship. When not cheering on the team from the stands or the field, the marching band was busy performing at other locales, such as the York Fair Band Showcase, the Red Lion Sound Spectacular, the Manchester Parade, the Dover Band Showcase, the York Halloween parade, and more. The marching band also prepared some patriotic tunes for the Vietnam Veterans Memorial Dedication at the York Fairgrounds. Additionally, the marching band will march in the Memorial Day Parade later this month.

Meanwhile, the concert band was preparing a variety of music for the Veterans Day Program at the York Expo Center and the quickly-approaching holiday season. The concert band learned a number of familiar holiday pieces for the forty-ninth annual Holiday Festival concert. Although the concert was postponed to early January due to inclement weather, the band put on a festive performance nonetheless. The jazz ensemble also performed in the concert, as well as in its fifth annual Holiday Jazz Night. Altogether, West York was brimming with festive spirit.

After two months of dedicated practice, the concert band was prepared for the annual Winter Festival of Winds, a combined concert with the jazz ensemble and middle school concert and jazz ensembles.
